What is **rightnow** MEDIA?

rightnow MEDIA is a free online library comprised of videos, Bible study, and leadership resources.

Bible Study Library

The Bible Study Library includes video discipleship content for every age group and every life situation. You can search by topic or browse through channels that include *Just Released, Marriage, Parenting, Youth,* and others. Many of the series have direct links to workbooks and leader's guides that you can purchase to go deeper into the topics.

rightnow MEDIA Kids is a video library full of fun, engaging and biblically sound programming that will draw your kids into a deeper journey of faith and devotion to Jesus.

Leadership Events Library

The Leadership Events Library includes leadership conference teaching sessions to stretch your faith and inspire you to grow. There are sessions included from Catalyst, Send North America, VERGE, D6, and others.

rightnow MEDIA Quick Start Steps

- 1. Look for an email with an invitation to register for your free rightnow MEDIA account.
- 2. Click the "Accept Invite" button and you will be taken to a registration page.
- 3. Fill out the information page, create a password and hit "go."
- 4. Next time you log in, enter the email you used to register and your password. Then explore!



- <u>It Starts at Home</u> (Matt Chandler) Explore biblical and tangible ways that parents couples, single parents, blended families and grandparents—can build a legacy of faith for their children.
- <u>Grace Based Parenting</u> (Tim Kimmel) Allow grace to be the center of parenting by exploring how to rely on God's love, replicate His forgiveness and commitment to His children, and displace fear as a motivator for every behavior.
- <u>The Essence of Orange</u> (Reggie Joiner) Understand the power of influencing the next generation when the church and family work together to teach them about God.
- <u>Sticky Faith</u> (Kara Powell) Develop strategies to build a faith in your kid that stick and continue to mature into adulthood. Avoid rearing kids that drift from their faith after high school graduation.
- <u>Raising a Modern Day Knight</u> (Robert Lewis) Equip boys to be men by cultivating a vision, a code of conduct, and a cause (Christianity) in which they invest their lives. Includes ideas for raising a boy to be a chivalrous and godly man.
- <u>Tough Guys and Drama Queens</u> (Mark Gregston) Learn tangible ways to engage with preteens and teens to avoid common pitfalls associated with the damaging effects of culture colliding with life.
- <u>Raise Up a Child</u> (Phil Tuttle) Explore four easy-to-remember parenting scenarios: choices, consequences, compassion, and consistency.
- <u>The Hurried Family</u> (Tim Kimmel) Reign in on the hurried pace of life by exploring symptoms of a hurried family and strategies for embedding calm in the rigors of life.





• <u>The Art of Marriage</u> (Family Life) Focus on developing a stronger marriage by exploring the Familylife Art of Marriage Conference materials which include God's purpose and plan, overcoming isolation, fulfilling our responsibilities, communication and conflict, experiencing real intimacy, and leaving a lasting legacy.

- <u>Visionary Marriage</u> (Rob Rienow) Explore what it means to develop a compelling Christian mission as part of your marriage and think about WHY God placed you with your spouse.
- House or Home (Chip Ingram) Gain insight into how to create a life-giving home-life with the stability to weather the storms of life.
- <u>You and Me Forever</u> (Francis and Lisa Chan) View marriage through the lens of the gospel by unpacking key topics related to the way lives are spent, intimacy, putting God first, distractions, and focus.



- <u>One Way Love</u> (Tullian Tchividjian) Take a look at God's inexhaustible grace—His oneway love. Look at how many Christians treat faith as a vehicle for good behavior and clean living rather than the only recourse for those who have failed over and over again.
- <u>Song of Solomon</u> (Tommy Nelson) Understand God's design for Biblical relationships by exploring the Song of Solomon. Follow Solomon's relationship from attraction to dating and courtship, marriage and intimacy to resolving conflict, keeping romance alive, and committing to the end.
- <u>Managing Our Finances God's Way</u> (Crown Financial) Examine the wise counsel God provides in scripture related to money and possessions through topics such as planned spending, the big picture, giving as worship, saving / investing, debt, and enjoyment.
- <u>The Prodigal God</u> (Tim Keller) Glean new and refreshing insight into the powerful message of Jesus' best-known—and least understood—parable by understanding God's radical love for sinners of every kind.
- <u>The Liberate Conference Messages</u> Watch conference messages designed to calibrate believers to Jesus' mission: "I have come to set the captives free" (Luke 4:18). Cultivate a fresh understanding of the mission to announce this liberating word to a wounded and worn out world, hoping that they will hear and rest in the freedom that Jesus came, died, and lives to give.
- <u>Linger Conference Messages</u> Be transformed in the presence of God by lingering in worship, prayer, meditation on Scripture, and reflection.



- <u>33 the Series, volumes 1 3</u> (Publisher Authentic Manhood) Explore "authentic manhood" as modeled by Jesus Christ in His 33 years on earth. Topics include God's design for men, embracing the past and its effect on the future and going below the surface to look deeply into the heart.
- <u>Stepping Up</u> (Dennis Rainey) Dig deeper into what it means to step up and live a courageous life by unpacking what biblical manhood looks like and what it means to be a godly, courageous man in today's world.
- <u>Nehemiah</u> (Matt Chandler) Explore the importance of God's Word, the reality of opposition, God's power to restore broken lives and the need for prayer through a study in Nehemiah.
- <u>Work as Worship</u> (Matt Chandler) Consider what it means to view whatever fills the hours of 9 to 5 —planting crops, building cars, taking care of patients, teaching students, running a business—as a way of connecting faith to work through worship.




Top Picks for Women
